Personal Protection in the Home

I will be starting an NRA Personal Protection in the Home Class starting in early February, probably about the second Monday evening.

This class is a twelve hour class with about half of that time devoted to lecture and about half to live firing at our Vale Range.

Cost is \$75.00 for non SRS members and \$60 for SRS members. We will be firing air guns, 22 caliber handguns and center fire handguns in the live fire portion.

SRS will supply all the necessary texts and can supply handguns as well as eye and hearing protection if you need them you will need to supply about two boxes of 22 long rifle ammunition and one box of center fire pistol ammunition. We will cover all of that the first night.

I try to teach a pretty relaxed class with emphasis on safety and basic handgun marksmanship. If you have little or no experience with handguns that is ok I start at the very beginning. If you are an old hand with a handgun that is fine too as I will probably use you to help with the new shooters.

This class fulfills one of the requirements for obtaining a Concealed Carry.

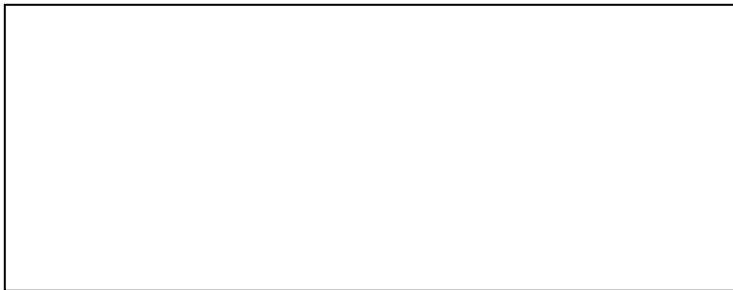
