

Snake River Sportsmen, CMP Approved, **John C. Garand Match** Saturday, June 10, 2006

Rules: Current CMP/NRA rules will govern. Open to NRA members and non-members.

Targets: NRA SR200 yd targets for the John C. Garand Match, and the MR target for the optional 600 yd match.

Classification: NRA classification will be used except that Unclassified will shoot as unclassified.

Rifles Allowed: Only Rack Grade M-1 Garands, M1903, 1903A3, Johnson Semi-auto Rifle, M1917 Enfield, or US Carbine Cal. .30. (Match Grade M-1 or other rifles may be used but will not be eligible for awards.) Ammunition for .30-06 or .30 Carbine will be M-2 Ball or Military Carbine ammunition or the hand loaded or commercial equivalent. No hand loads will be fired in Club M-1's, only M-2 Ball.

Entry Fee: \$20.00 for Match 1-5. The Club can provide M-1 Garands out of Club inventory for use in this match. M-2 Ball from Club inventory for use on the line only is \$11.00 for 55 rounds and \$15.00 for 77 rounds, and you keep the brass.

Scoring and Target Pullers: Competitors are required to score and pull targets.

Challenge Fee: \$2.00 per challenge. Fee is collected on the line and returned if you win the challenge.

Entries: Send entries to David J. Brown at the address above. Post Entries will be accepted up to the range limit.

Match Schedule: Registration 8:30 AM Saturday, June 10, 2006. Match starts at 9:00 AM. Match 1: 200 yards, prone slow fire, with up to 5 sighter shots. You may take fewer than 5 sighters, but must inform the scorer prior to firing for record. Time limit 25 minutes.

Match 2: 200 yards, rapid fire prone from standing, 10 record shots, 70 seconds.

Match 3: 200 yards, rapid fire sitting from standing, 10 record shots, 60 seconds.

Match 4, 200 yards, slow fire standing, 10 record shots. Time limit 10 minutes.

Match 5 (Optional) 600 yards, Prone low fire, 2 sighter shots and 20 record shots, 22 minutes.

Awards: Cash awards for all except junior shooters, who will receive medallions. Awards based on the aggregate of Match 1-4. Awards for Match Winner, Classification Winner, Junior Match Winner, and for each five places in classification. Classes may be grouped if there are too few competitors at the Match Director's discretion.

Directions: The SRS Range Complex is located 2 miles south of Vale, OR off of Lytle Blvd. Turn south on Glenn St., which becomes Lytle Blvd. outside Vale. A standard highway sign is located at the turn-off to the range, then cross a cattle guard and follow the road to the left.

Special Note: Competitors must have a NOTARIZED Eligibility affidavit and Liability Agreement on file PRIOR to this match. Contact the Match Director for a copy of this form, you will not be allowed to fire without it.

Competitors must be at least 16 years of age to compete and 18 years old to purchase a rifle from CMP. Competitors in this match will qualify to purchase an M-1 from CMP and we will have sales packets.
