These classes fulfill one of the requirements for obtaining a Concealed Carry Permit in Idaho or Oregon. They are a twelve hour class and are about half shooting and about half lecture. Generally we meet on Monday evening from 7:00PM to 9:00 PM at the SRS Shotgun Field house and do the shooting at our Vale Range. Because we quite often have inexperienced shooters taking this class I will start at the very beginning of handgun safety and basic handgun marksmanship and try to make these classes come off in a very relaxed atmosphere. We can supply handguns or you can supply your own and you will supply your own ammunition; we supply text books and can supply eye and hearing protection or you can use your own.

Cost of the class is \$65.00 for SRS members and \$75.00 for non members.
