

Snake River Sportsmen NRA Approved 600 yard Long Range and Palma Rifle Match

Saturday, July 14, 2007, and Saturday, August 11, 2007

Sponsored by Snake River Sportsmen

Directions to Range: Take Lytle Blvd approximately two miles south of Vale, OR. In Vale, go south on Glenn St. S. and it becomes Lytle Blvd across the river. A highway sign marks the entrance road to the range, then turn left after crossing the cattle guard.

Rules: NRA Rules regulating Long Range and Palma matches apply. Rifles will conform to rule 3.3.3 and rule 3.1 and 3.1.1 for the Palma Match, and rule 3.3 in addition to 3.3.3, 3.1, and 3.1.1 for the 600 yard Match. Rifles using cartridges other than .308 Win. (7.62 NATO) will be eligible for this match. Match winner must use a .308 rifle. Rifles using telescopic sights will be allowed to fire but will not be eligible for awards and will not have scores reported to the NRA.

Eligibility: Matches open to all shooters, you need not be an NRA member.

Entries close: July 13, 2007, and August 10, 2007. Post entries will be accepted to the close of the registration period, at 8:45 AM the day of the Match. Entry fee: \$20.

Entry Limit: Entries will be limited to 60 competitors, which is the range limit.

Firing Starts: 9:00 AM July 14 and August 11, 2007.

Classification: Standard NRA Classification will be used. Shooters not classified will fire in the highest available class. If there are fewer than five competitors in a class we may combine with the next highest available class.

Awards: Awards will be cash, except for the overall match winner, who will be awarded a plaque, too. Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the Match. Awards will be based on the aggregate of the 600 yd and Palma Match only.

Match Schedule: The 600 yd Match firing begins at 9:00 AM. Two sighters followed by twenty rounds for record at 600 yd within a time limit of twenty-two minutes. Target MR. Competitors will be required to pull targets and score. Challenges \$2.00 per challenge. Rifles and ammunition see Rules, above, and NRA rulebook. F class may fire but will not be eligible for awards.

The Palma Rifle Match starts after the conclusion of the 600 yd Match. Fifteen record rounds at 800 yd, fifteen rounds at 900 yd, and fifteen rounds at 1,000 yd. Unlimited sighting shots at each stage, shooter must tell scorer before record shots begin, and may not go back to sighters after firing for record. Time limit is twenty two minutes per stage including sighting shots. Competitors will be required to pull targets and to score. Challenge fee \$2.00 per challenge. Rifles and ammunition see Rules, above, and NRA rulebook. Other rifles may fire but will not be eligible for awards, nor will scores be reported to NRA.
