

Snake River Sportsmen's NRA Approved Palma Rifle Match And 600 Yd. Mid Range Rifle Matches

Direction to Range; The range is located on Lytle Blvd approximately 2 miles south of Vale, Oregon. There is a standard highway sign marking the range entrance on Lytle Blvd. (the road from Vale to Adrian, Oregon)

Rules: Standard NRA rules regulating Mid Range and Palma Rifle matches apply. Rifles will conform to rule 3.3, 3.2 and 3.1 and 3.1.1 for the Palma Match and for the 600 yd Match. Rifles using any caliber other than .308 will be eligible for this match. Rifles using telescopic sights will be allowed to fire but will not be eligible for awards in Match Rifle. Scores of Rifles using telescopic sights will not be reported to the NRA with the exception of F Class. F Class Rifles will be governed by current NRA F Class Rifle Rules.

Matches open to: Matches are open to all shooters; you need not be an NRA Member.

Entry Fee: Match fee will be \$20.00 for the match.

Entries Close: July 9, August 13 and September 10, 2011.

Post Entries: Post entries will be accepted to the close of the registration period 8:45 AM May 08 July 10 and September 11 2010.

Sign up will start at 8:30 AM match day for those not pre registered.

Entry Limit: Entries will be limited to 30 competitors which is the range limit.

Firing Starts: Registration Starts at 8:30 AM and firing starts at 9:00 AM.

Classification: Standard NRA Classification will be used. Shooters not classified will fire in the highest available classification. If there are fewer than five competitors in a class we may combine with the next highest available class. If fewer than five High Masters enter they will compete for Match Winner only. F Class may fire and will be awarded in F Class only. F Class will not be eligible for overall Match winner but will be awarded F Class Match Winner. F Class will use the new F Class NRA Classification.

Targets MR, LR, NRA Approved F Class Mid Range and Long Range.

Awards: Awards will be cash except for the overall match winner and F Class Match Winner who will be awarded a plaque and a cash award. Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the Match. Awards will be based on the aggregate of the 600 yd and Palma match only.

Match Schedule: For the 600 yd match firing starts 9:00 AM. Twenty rounds for record with two sighters at 600 yards time limit will be twenty two minutes. Target MR. Competitors will be required to pull targets and score. Challenges \$2.00 / challenge Rifles and ammunition see Rules.

The Palma Rifle Match firing starts at the conclusion of the 600 yd match Fifteen record rounds at 800 yards, fifteen rounds at 900 yds and fifteen rounds at 1,000 yds unlimited sighters, you must tell scorer when sighters are complete and may not go back to sighters once firing for record starts. Time limit is twenty two minutes per stage to include sighter shots. Competitors will be required to score and pull targets. Challenge fee \$2.00 / challenge. Rifles and ammunition see rules for eligible rifles and ammunition. Other rifles may fire but will not be eligible for awards nor will scores be reported to the NRA.

General information: Dry camping is allowed on the SRS Vale Range contact Dr David Brown for combination for lock and rules regulating camping on the range.
